

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

2nd Joint Meeting of the North American Society for Pediatric Exercise Medicine and the European Group for Pediatric Work Physiology

September 22-26, 2010, Queen's Landing Hotel
Niagara-on-the-Lake, Ontario, Canada

Abstract submission guidelines are as follows:

The length of the abstract should not exceed 300 words. Single-space the abstract except between the title/author lines and the beginning of the abstract. Use 12-point Times Roman font. Indicate any sources of funding or disclosures, as appropriate. All abstracts must be submitted electronically.

Example:

Effects of Yellow Submarine Travel on Oxygen Consumption
R. Starr, J. Lennon, P. McCartney, G. Harrison, Abbey Road, London, UK.

The abstract should begin by stating the purpose of the study, possibly preceded by an introductory statement. The subjects, methods, and mode of data analysis should be included in sufficient detail for others to determine their appropriateness. A summary of the findings should provide the reader with a clear description of the results and brief discussion of their relevance.

Each abstract is to be submitted with a cover letter that includes the primary author's complete address, telephone number, FAX number (if available) and email address. Also, **please indicate your preference for presentation: Oral or Poster.**

If the primary author is a graduate or undergraduate student and would like to be considered for the Student Research Award, the student should indicate this on the cover sheet accompanying the abstract. To qualify for this award, the research must have been completed during a full-time graduate or undergraduate program and the student was responsible for carrying out the project (development of problem, data collection and analysis, writing abstract, and preparing presentation).

Prepare the abstract using Microsoft Word and submit as an attached file.
