NASPEM 2024 Biennial Meeting - Abstract Guidelines

Oral and Posters Presentations

Please follow the formatting instructions below when submitting an abstract for an oral or poster presentation to NASPEM 2024:

- Use a standard scientific structure to prepare the abstract, including the headings: Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
- An abstract must be entered into the online Abstract Submission Form.
- Abstracts are restricted to 2,000 characters, including spaces (excluding abstract titles, names, and affiliations).
- Abstracts must be submitted in 12-point Times New Roman font.
- Statements like "Data will be presented and discussed" are unacceptable.
- Authors should be formatted as: Smith, J.A.1, Jones, G.A.2, & Frank, T.L.3
- Institutions should be listed as: 1. Applied Sports, Technology, Exercise and Medicine Research Centre, Swansea University, UK
- Abstracts should not contain tables or graphs and are restricted to ASCII-characters only. Please note that an abstract prepared in a program such as Word may contain non-ASCII characters.
- All abstract content is the sole responsibility of the author(s) of the abstract.
- You can preview your abstract during the submission process. Abstracts will be printed exactly as they appear in the preview (simple text format).
- On submission, you will receive an email confirmation indicating whether you have successfully submitted your abstract.
- Editing is only possible at this stage.

Student Awards

If the primary author is a graduate or undergraduate student who wants to be considered for the Student Research Award, the student should indicate this in the abstract submission. To qualify for this award, the research must have been completed during a full-time graduate or undergraduate program, and the student must have been responsible for carrying out the project (development of the problem, data collection and analysis, writing the abstract, and preparing presentation).

Presentation Formats

- Standard Oral Communication: 10-minute presentation, 3 minutes for questions
 - Presentations will follow a standard scientific format with no limit on the number of slides presented within the time frame.
- Poster
 - Posters will be viewable during coffee breaks for informal presentations and questions.
